Education and Experience:

- Preferred Associate degree or higher in parks and recreation, community health and fitness, physical education, leisure studies or related field
- Experience in parks and recreation, programming and special event planning
- Experience or knowledge in the following areas
 - Youth and adult programs
 - Media outreach, promotions and public speaking
 - Special events development and operation
 - Fitness programs
 - Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) regulations and access requirements
 - Staff hiring, supervision, evaluation and training, particularly for fitness instructors and programmatic leaders.

Responsible to:

• Reports to, works at the direction of and is evaluated by Parks & Recreation Director.

Duties:

- Plans, operates and facilitates community programs, classes and events.
- Employs and entrepreneurial approach to work, proactively initiating, managing and sustaining new programs in response to community needs.
- Serves as liaison between departments and community groups.
- Works with public- and private-sector partners to reserve space for programs.
- Promotes use of county parks, trails and recreation facilities.
- Partners with media, social media and the public to increase awareness of and participation in county recreational programs
- Prepares media releases on upcoming events
 - Utilizing social media, press, TV and radio as available.
- Helps ensure recreation department's compliance with all local, state and federally mandated programs and requirements for access.
- Assists in supervising/managing Rural Retreat Campground and Pool.
 - Includes but not limited to maintenance at campground and pool.
 - Develops community programs for increasing pool usage.
- Assists in supervising sporting events as needed.
- Support the overall development and growth of the department's offerings & initiatives.
- Operation of a county vehicle to complete program tasks.
- Completes all other duties as assigned by the Director.

Special Requirements

- Physical work requires the occasional exertion of up to 50 pounds of force; frequently requires standing, kneeling, walking, lifting, etc.; requires exposure to outdoor weather conditions
- Works in a variety of settings, including assigned county office space, schools, outdoors and in a variety of program spaces.
- Must possess a valid driver's license.
