- 1. Bidder has visited the Site, conducted a thorough, visual examination of the Site and adjacent areas, and become familiar with and satisfied itself as to the general, local, and site conditions that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.
- 2. Bidder is familiar with and has satisfied itself as to all Laws and Regulations that may affect cost, progress, and performance of the Work.

- 3. Bidder has considered the information known to Bidder itself; information commonly known to contractors doing business in the locality of the Site; information and observations obtained from visits to the Site; the Bidding Documents; and any Site-related reports and drawings identified in the Bidding Documents, with respect to the effect of such information, observations, and documents on (1) the cost, progress, and performance of the Work; (2) the means, methods, techniques, sequences, and procedures of construction to be employed by Bidder; and (3) Bidder's safety precautions and programs.

#### Scope and SPECIFICATIONS:

- 1. Coordinate with The Town of Wytheville (TOW) for Permits and Regulations
- Install signs and barriers as required to close the construction area as per TOW standards.
- Mill Existing Pavement.
- 4. Proof roll sub-grade and Stone with loaded Tandem Truck to the approval of the County Engineering Department.
- Remove and repair with VDOT 357 stone, any soft areas found during proof roll.
- 6. Add VDOT 21B stone as needed.
- Compact VDOT 21B stone with smooth barrel roller capable of achieving the specified density.
- 8. Install Prime Coat as per VDOT standards.
- 9. Install SM 9.5 AL as per VDOT standards.
- Stripe Stalls of Parking lot 10 wide and 20 feet long with water base striping paint. Stripe ADA parking as Shown.
- Install ADA signs with aluminum and retro reflective coating as per VDOT Standards.
- 12. Install VDOT 21B shoulder stone as shown .
- 13. Dispose of all construction material properly.
- 14. Asphalt shall be 250 Degrees F minimum at placement.
- 15. Utilize smooth barrel roller. Establish Roller Pattern.
- 16. The asphalt provider shall be in the VDOT Quality Assurance Program.
- 17. All scale tickets to be delivered to the 3rd party Inspector and the Inspector shall deliver the scale tickets to the Wythe County.

Minimum Density will be 92.5% for SM and BM. Contact local quarry.












# TYPICAL SIDEWALK Expansion Joint SECTION NO SCALE

#### Scope and SPECIFICATIONS:

- Coordinate with The Town of Wytheville for Permits and Regulations. Install signs and barriers as required to close the construction area as per Wythe County and the Town of Wytheville.
- Excavate/Remove existing Sidewalk material.
- Install forms.
- Pour Concrete as per VDOT Sidewalk Standards and Specifications.
   Install Crack control joints every 5 feet and expansion material every 20 feet.
- Finish with a broom finish.
- Install Quikrete Cure and Seal as soon as concrete is finished.

- 3. Compact. Repair soft spots as directed by County Engineer.

- 5. Install 1.5" SM
- Stripe "Loading Zone No Parking " as show with white parking lot paint.
- 7. 45 Degrees on angle of stripe.
- 8. 4" minimum stripe.
- 9. 4' between stripes.
- 10. 1 Foot minimum Letter height.






- 2. Mill out existing asphalt at the entrance.

- 3. Dispose of Milled material at Mattney Flats (Henley Mountain) tower access road.
- 4. Excavate and grade the existing stone to the typical section above (match existing grade if possible).
- 5. Prime stone and the sides of the concrete at pads 0.15 gal/SY.
- 6. Install BM 25 asphalt to VDOT standard and specifications.
