

**AMENDMENT NO. 2  
TO ORDINANCE NO. 88-2  
PEDDLERS AND ITINERANT MERCHANTS ORDINANCE OF  
WYTHE COUNTY, VIRGINIA**

A public hearing was held on June 13, 2000, at 7:15 p.m. in the Board Room of the Wythe County Office Building, 275 South Fourth Street, Wytheville, Virginia, to consider amending Ordinance No. 88-2, "Peddlers and Itinerant Merchants Ordinance of Wythe County, Virginia", as follows:

**Add the following subsection to Article VII:**

7.2:4 No applicant shall offer any merchandise for sale at any location within 1,000 feet of an established business building or premises, nor in such a location that parking facilities for such established business will necessarily be utilized by customers of the permit holder unless approval is granted in writing by the established business.

**Amend Article VIII as follows:**

8.1 Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided by the Code of Virginia.

Supervisor Porter made a motion to approve the foregoing amendment. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Sharitz and the roll call vote is as follows:
