

ORDINANCE NO. 2002-4
AN ORDINANCE DISCONTINUING AND VACATING AN ALLEYWAY
LOCATED BETWEEN PAINTERS HILL ROAD, PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE
AND THIRD STREET IN THE COMMUNITY OF IVANHOE
LEAD MINES MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT, WYTHE COUNTY, VIRGINIA

WHEREAS, property adjoining an alleyway located between Painters Hill Road, Pennsylvania Avenue and Third Street, which is the estate of Marion Dyer Jackson, Sr., and Erlene S. Jackson in the community of Ivanhoe, Lead Mines Magisterial District, Wythe County, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, it appears that no inconvenience will result to others from a discontinuance of portions of said streets and alleyways; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.2-2006 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, permits the discontinuance of alleys, streets, and other public areas laid out or described in plats of records; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of Section 15.2-2006 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, notice required thereby was duly given.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained that the alleyways which are shown on that Gregory B. Armentrout survey plat dated July 7, 2002, (also see Tax Map 87, Parcel 7), which is attached to this ordinance and is hereby made a part of this ordinance by reference; in the Community of Ivanhoe, Lead Mines Magisterial District, Wythe County, Virginia, is hereby discontinued and vacated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded as deeds are recorded and indexed in the name of the County of Wythe, Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Wythe County, Virginia.

This ordinance was duly considered following a required public hearing held on December 10, 2002, and was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Wythe County, Virginia, at its regular meeting held on December 10, 2002, the members voting:
