

**AN ORDINANCE DISCONTINUING AND VACATING PORTIONS OF  
FIRST STREET AND CARROLL AVENUE IN THE  
COMMUNITY OF IVANHOE, LEAD MINES MAGISTERIAL DISTRICT,  
WYTHE COUNTY, VIRGINIA  
ORDINANCE NO. 96-2**

WHEREAS, property adjoining portions of First Street and Carroll Avenue, owned by Bessie Rash Sangster and Robert R. Sangster, Sr., in the community of Ivanhoe, Lead Mines Magisterial District, Wythe County, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, it appears that no inconvenience will result to others from a discontinuance of portions of said street and avenue; and

WHEREAS, Section 15.1-482 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, permits the discontinuance of alleys, streets, and other public areas laid out or described in plats of record; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provision of Section 15.1-431 of the Code of Virginia, 1950, as amended, notice required thereby was duly given.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained those portions of First Street and Carroll Avenue which are shaded in green on a plat which is attached to this ordinance and is hereby made a part of this ordinance by reference, in the community of Ivanhoe, Lead Mines Magisterial District, Wythe County, Virginia, are hereby discontinued and vacated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that a certified copy of this ordinance be recorded as deeds are recorded and indexed in the name of the County of Wythe, Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Wythe County, Virginia.

This ordinance was duly considered following a required public hearing held on March 19, 1996, and was adopted by the Board of Supervisors of Wythe County, Virginia, at its regular meeting held on March 19, 1996, the members voting:
