

AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE CERTAIN STREETS NEAR  
MAX MEADOWS' SCHOOL

WHEREAS, the County School Board of Wythe County presented its petition to the Board of Supervisors of Wythe County on the 5th day of July, 1968, requesting that the Board of Supervisors vacate certain portions of streets and alleys within or abutting the School Board's property at Max Meadows, Wythe County, Virginia as shown on a plat attached to and made a part of said petition; and

WHEREAS, by resolution adopted on said date the Board of Supervisors directed the Attorney for the Commonwealth to publish in the Southwest Virginia Enterprise, a newspaper published and circulated in Wythe County, Virginia, a legal notice required by Section 15.1-482 of the Code of Virginia that a public hearing would be held on this matter at 11:30 a.m. on the 9th day of August, 1968, in the Circuit Court Room of the Court House in Wytheville, Virginia; and

WHEREAS, due notice of said public hearing was published in the Southwest Virginia Enterprise on July 25 and August 1, 1968, the last publication being not less than 5 nor more than 10 days prior to the date of said public hearing as required by statute; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the question of vacating said portions of said streets and alleys and all persons appearing at said hearing were given ample opportunity to be heard; and

WHEREAS, all or virtually all of said portions of said streets and alleys lie within the boundary of the property owned by the County School Board of Wythe County used by it for school purposes in the Community of Max Meadows; and

WHEREAS, said portions of said streets and alleys have never opened or improved; and

WHEREAS, it is clearly in the public interest for the portions of said streets and alleys to be vacated in order that the County School Board of Wythe County may proceed with certain proposed improvements in the area:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED that the portions of streets and alleys located at Max Meadows, Wythe County, Virginia, referred to in the petition of the County School Board of Wythe County filed with the Board of Supervisors of Wythe County on July 5, 1968, be and they are vacated. There is attached hereto and made a part hereof a plat prepared by Homer D. Winter, Jr., Certified Land Surveyor, dated April 12, 1968, and revised on June 4, 1968, and June 21, 1968, on which the segments of the streets and alleys vacated are outlined in red.

It is further ORDAINED that a certified copy of this ordinance and a print of said map be recorded in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Court of Wythe County as deeds are recorded.
