

**AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO ORDINANCE NO. 96-4  
WATER USE AND MANAGEMENT ORDINANCE  
OF WYTHE COUNTY, VIRGINIA**

A public hearing was held on the 13th day of April 2010 at 7:05 p.m. in the Board Room of the Wythe County Administration Building, 340 South Sixth Street, Wytheville, Virginia to consider amendment 2 to Wythe County Ordinance #96-4 entitled, "Water Use and Management Ordinance of Wythe County, Virginia."

**DELETE:**

7.4 Customers water service will be disconnected for nonpayment of water bills when customer has a bill 30 days past due. Prior to a non-pay disconnect, the customer will be mailed a late notice giving him a 10 day period to pay the bill in full. After the late notices are mailed, customer must pay his bill in full, including the current bill, within the 10 day period at the office of the Wythe County Water Department or his service will be disconnected.

**ADD:**

7.4 Customers water service will be disconnected for nonpayment of water bills when customer has a bill 10 days past due. Prior to a non-pay disconnect, the customer will be mailed a late notice giving him a 10 day period to pay the bill in full. After the late notices are mailed, customer must pay his bill in full including penalty and interest, within the 10 day period at the office of the Wythe County Water Department. If the bill has not been paid in full the customers service shall be disconnected on the 11<sup>th</sup> day.

Supervisor Umberger made a motion to approve this amendment. The motion was seconded by Supervisor Poole and the roll call vote is as follows:
